

Activity Log

An activity log can be used to capture specific errors individual students make week by week.

Day of the Week Activity Log

A simple weekly log shows:

- Student names down the left-hand side
- Days of the week across the top

Teachers note a specific student error in the appropriate cell. For instance, if the student should have said /t/ but instead says /d/, the teacher would write:

/t/ (/d/)

If the student should have read /mit/ but instead read /mat/, the teacher would write:

/mit/ (/mat/)

An example of an activity log organized by day of the week:

STUDENT NAMES	MONDAY	TUESDAY	WEDNESDAY	THURSDAY	FRIDAY

Skill Activity Log

A simple skill log shows:

- Student names down the left-hand side
- The target skill at the top
- Columns to indicate if each student needs extra intervention or has mastered the given skill

An example of an activity log organized by skill:
